Taylor Wimpey is delighted to invite you to attend public consultation events on our emerging proposals for Gomm Valley.

Since acquiring the site in May 2021, we have been engaging with Buckinghamshire Council and a number of local stakeholders to better understand their priorities for the site. Whilst the detailed proposals are still evolving, the proposed landscape-led development will deliver much needed new housing, alongside a primary school, community facilities, employment uses, large areas of open space, ecological enhancements and integration with the existing community.

Taylor Wimpey is mindful that there has been considerable discussion surrounding development at Gomm Valley over the past few years. We are keen to build on the previous consultation, with a keen focus on ensuring the deliverability of the site and its associated community benefits.

The site was initially allocated as a 'reserve site' in 2008 before being subsequently released for development in 2014 to help meet the District's housing need. Since then, the site has been the subject of the Gomm Valley and Ashwells Development Brief (2017) and was then reallocated for development in the adopted Wycombe Local Plan (2019).

Taylor Wimpey's proposals will deliver much needed market and affordable housing within High Wycombe. With landscape considerations at the heart of the proposals, the development will protect the on-site ancient woodland, SSSI, and other ecological features, whilst delivering biodiversity enhancements and significant areas of publicly accessible open space to be enjoyed by new and existing residents.
