Nature is one of the priority themes in our environmental strategy and we have set targets to increase biodiversity on our sites and install our priority wildlife enhancements. We are also partnering with NGOs Buglife and Hedgehog Street to help us develop our approach and get customers involved. We can also support this goal through sustainable sourcing of natural resources like timber. Our tender documents and trade specifications state that we require all suppliers to supply timber from responsibly managed forests certified by recognised schemes.
